**English**

**Objectives:**

The objectives of this course are:

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**Geography**

**Objectives:**

The objectives of this course are:

- vi. The objectives of this course are to integrate the various factors of economic development and to acquaint the students about this dynamic aspect of economic geography.
- vii. The objective of this paper is to provide an overview of resource geography and its interface with environment.
- viii. The course is designed so as to present the role of the geographical positioning of Maharashtra in moulding its geopolitical personality and its inter-relations with other states.
- ix. The course is meant to provide an understanding of spatial and structural dimensions of population and the emerging issues. The course is further aimed at familiarizing the students with global and regional level problems and also equip them for comprehending the Indian situation.

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**PSYCHOLOGY**

**Objectives:**

The objectives of this course are:

- i. To provide solid foundation for the basic principles of psychology.
- ii To familiarize students with the historical trends in psychology, major concepts, theoretical perspectives, and empirical findings.
- iii. To provide an overview of the applications of psychology.
- iv. To enable student to appreciate how individual behaviors is Influenced by social and cultural contexts.
- v. To enable student to develop an understanding of functioning of dyads, groups and organization.
- vi. To understand the unique feature of the Indian socio-cultural context.
- vii To understand how social problems can be analyzed in terms of various social psychological theories.
- viii. To enable student to make the connection between psychology and its practical application to everyday life.
- ix. To train student how psychological principles can help them to face life's challenges.
- x. To enables students to relate what they are learning in class to issues that they encounter in their everyday life, such as stress, health, work, personal relationships, communication and self-esteem.
- xi. To create interest in psychological phenomenon.
- xii. To develop awareness of psychological tools, techniques and tests.
- xiii. To nurture the skill of observation.

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**Political Science**

**Objectives:**

- iv. The dominant theories of power and the question of equity and justice, the different aspects of balance of power leading to the present situation of a unipolar world are included.
- v. This course will give introduction to the students of political journalism aims to provide voters with the information to formulate their own opinion and participate in community, local to global matter that will effect then.
- vi. Political journalism is provided through different mediums in print, broadcast, online reporting, instant coverage of campaign, politics, event news, government status, election updates etc.
